2015 Chamber Objectives / Results

In 2015, your Chamber Board established several objectives for your Chamber's efforts. Here are the results:

Operations

- Exceed the North American Chamber average membership retention rate of 86%.
Result: 92.4%
- Grow membership by 3% by year end.
Result: Membership revenue grew by 3.76%
- Generate a profit from Business View magazine by end of plan period.
Result: Loss of \$6,756. More targeted distribution and redirection of Buyer's Guide/Map advertising to Business View for 2016.
- Generate a net surplus on operations by year-end.
Result: Surplus of \$23,641 for the year with a retained surplus of \$528,981.
- Renewal of National Accreditation with Distinction.
Result: Completed

Advocacy

- Continue "Target 8,000" reports monthly during plan period.
Result: Reports issued each quarter.
- Continue to press the "Productivity in Government" agenda and succeed in getting at least one more institution formally adopting a productivity agenda before end of plan period.
Result:
 - SaskEnergy shared accumulative savings over \$33 million.
 - Eighth City of Saskatoon Productivity report showed accumulative savings over \$32 million.
 - 1st "Productivity in Government and Business Conference" in Canada.
 - Several lean initiatives are underway at the Saskatoon Health Region and Provincial Government Departments.
 - The Saskatchewan Rate Review Panel now requires a productivity report with each rate increase request from SaskPower, SaskEnergy, and SGI.
 - SaskPower has an internal savings target of \$2 billion over 10 years.
- Continue to press for property tax competitiveness improvement. Our tax elasticity model developed with the assistance of Dr. Adam Found is the first of its kind in Canada and will be used as part of our core advocacy work.
Result: City and Provincial efforts are ongoing. Progress on Provincial property tax competitiveness is slow but proceeding. Much work still needed to achieve our objective of having the best property tax policy in the country.

Result: Evolving - social media of growing importance for our Chamber with quickly improving member take up.
- Add two new member outreach tactics through new media.
Result: Facebook and Twitter are our primary tools. Other tactics including webinars are continually evolving in this fast change business space.

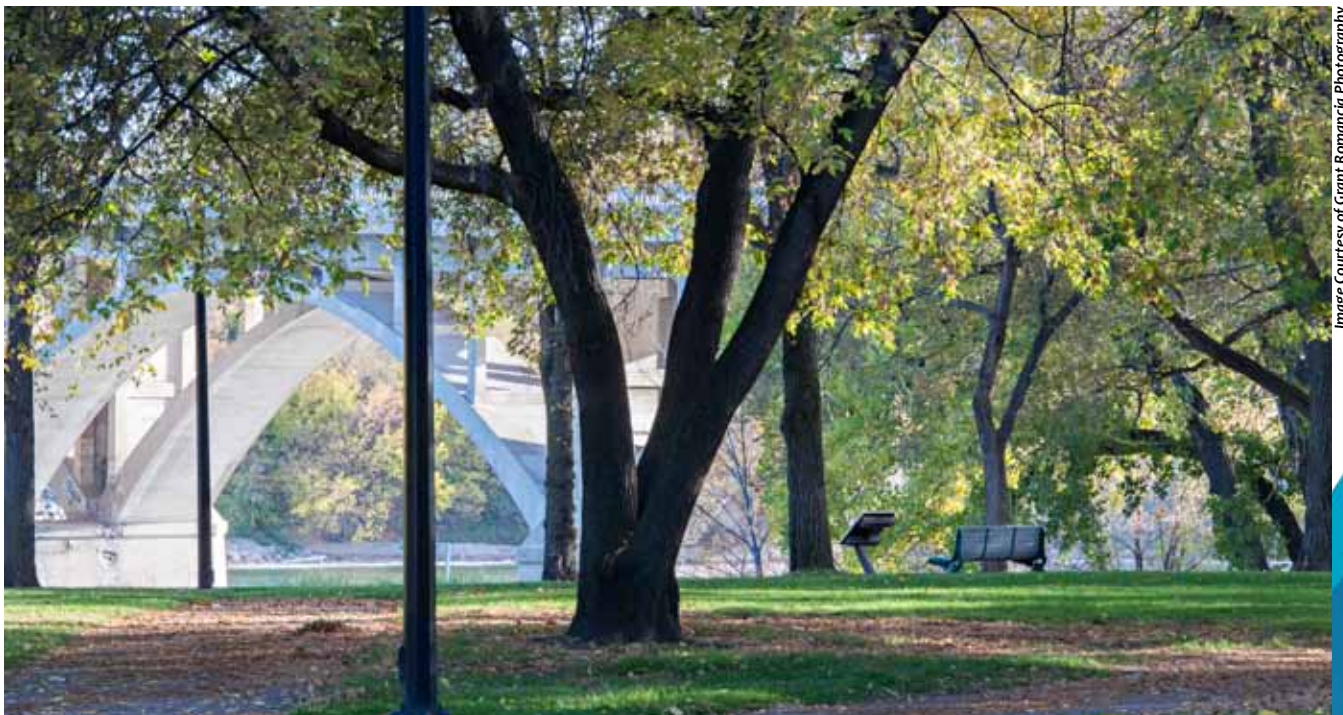
